This study, commonly known as the "Section 5 Study," was required by Section 5 of Act 65 by the Vermont State Legislature in 2005. Act 65 required Omya to finance a review of the environmental and human health impacts of calcium carbonate processing at Omya's Florence Plant. Over the last two years, the study was overseen by a group known as the "Section 5 Oversight Team," and was conducted by independent, third-party scientists. The final findings of the study were submitted to the Legislature on February 19, 2008.
